## 20'DV - Standard

DRY FREIGHT CONTAINERS - 20'DV - STANDARD

20 foot standard container (20 Dry Freight Container, 20 foot, 20 ' $\mathrm{dv}, 20 \mathrm{dc}$ ) - it is the most common type of containers. Used for transporting wide variety of goods, that are suitable by size and don't require special conditions for the transporting.

Walls of the standard rectangle container are made from corrugated metal with doors located in one end. Very often wooden flooring is used inside the 20 foot standard container.

## 20'HC - High Cube

DRY FREIGHT HIGH CONTAINERS - 20'HC - HIGH CUBE

20 foot High Cube ( $20^{\prime} \mathrm{hc}$, high) container - is one feet ( 30 cm ) higher than standard container. Often use of the high cube container can significantly reduce the cost of transportation because of increased intensity of the load.
